Eligible fish must be captured within Port Hacking Game Fishing Club waters:

Northern Boundary:

Southern Boundary:

Kiama Lighthouse

All captures must occur within these boundaries to be eligible.

WEIGH-IN RULES

- All Tuna must be weighed at Port Hacking Game Fishing Club.
- Official weigh station is located at Royal Motor Yacht Club (RMYC).

1. All tackle and fishing practices must comply with current NSWGFA Rules.
2. Entrants must be current financial members of Port Hacking Game Fishing Club.
3. All fish must be legally captured in accordance with NSW Fisheries regulations.
4. Tournament officials reserve the right to inspect tackle, captures and supporting information.
5. In the event of a tie, the first fish weighed will be deemed the winner.
6. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend rules where required.
7. By entering this event, all participants agree to abide by tournament rules and committee decisions.
